### **SPENDING ON ISSUE 1**

For Issue 1 \$58.3 million 60% from PACs 50% from Out-of-State Donors **Open Society Policy Center** ACLU Planned Parenthood 1630 Fund **Fairness Project** Lynn Schusterman

Against Issue 1 \$36.6 million 93% from PACs 91% from Out-of-State Donors Susan B. Anthony Pro-Life Concord Fund \$2 million from Individuals

### Where was the Money Spent?

- Television Advertising
- Radio Advertising
- On-Line Advertising
- Billboards
- Brochures & Doorhangers
- Consultant Fees
- Legal Fees
- Meals, Travel and Meetings
- Salaries

### So what Happened?

- > We were outspent
- We were out messaged Pro Issue 1 Ads were everywhere
- We lacked a coherent message with broad appeal
  - Late Term Abortion
  - Parental Rights
- > We ignored Suburban Women Voters
- > Our messaging was late in the campaign last 2 weeks
- > We did NOT chase early votes
- PACs against Issue 1 did NOT collaborate
- Passage of Issue 1 in August would have stopped this initiative

- > Won 64% of the vote

- Valley View Mayor Mathew March

- First Republican elected Mayor
- Flipped seat to Republican

- Garfield Hts. Municipal Court Judge Sergio DiGeronimo
- Lyndhurst Municipal Court Judge Dominic Coletta
- Rocky River Municipal Court Judge Joseph Burke
- South Euclid Municipal Court Judge Tim Sterkel

- > FIRST EVER REPUBLICAN IN HISTORY
- Ran in largely blue cities
- > Won 55% of the vote
- Flipped seat to Republican

- $\checkmark$  Robo Calls the day before the election
- ✓ Volunteers at ALL Polling Locations Every Shift
- $\checkmark\,$  Poll Flushing on election day
- $\checkmark\,$  Driving voters to the polls early voting & election day
